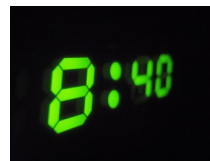

French Program Review - Public Meeting

A Program Review (PR) has been approved by the SCDSB Board of Trustees for our school. A proposed option is splitting the French as a Second Language program, with some grades attending Hillcrest Public School and the others attending Portage View Public School. All students in the English program would continue to attend their home school.

This review is being conducted to ensure balanced enrolment at our schools. The results of the review would take effect in September 2017.

We are hosting an information session to address parent questions and get feedback on the proposed changes.
